

# GENERAL INFORMATION

**AWARDS.** Individual Awards for the First and Second Place teams.  
Teams awards for First, Second and Third place teams.

**FORMAT.** 2 pool games seeding into an ASA double elimination bracket.

**UNIFORMS.** All players must compete in accordance with Rule 3, Section 6. UNIFORM of the 2010 ASA Official Rules of Softball.

**LINE-UP CARDS.** Tournament officials will provide line-up cards for each team.

**GAME TIMES.** Please follow the times listed on the official tournament bracket.  
Game time is forfeit time.  
Teams should be prepared to start a game immediately after the preceding game is completed.  
Pool and bracket games will be 1hr 40 min. time limits with the exception on the semi-final and final games.  
Semi-final and final games will be 7 innings.

**INFIELD PRACTICE.** No infield practice will be permitted.  
Warm-up is allowed in designated areas only.  
Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass if time permits.

**DOUGOUTS.** Players and coaches are the only individuals allowed in the dugouts.

**PROTESTS.** The tournament committee will decide all protests.  
As manager, please be familiar with the rules of the game including proper protest procedures.  
See **Rule 9, PROTESTS** of the **ASA Official Rules of Softball.**

**RUN AHEAD RULE.** Refer to **Rule 5, THE GAME, Section 9, RUN AHEAD RULE** of the **ASA Official Rules of Softball.**  
15 after 3, 12 after 4, 8 after 5.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER.** In the event of inclement weather, the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was suspended. Home team needs to note the exact point in which the game was suspended and time remaining and report it to the tournament director.

Broken Arrow Girls Softball takes the safety of the players, coaches & fans very serious. In the event of severe weather the lighting detector will sound a loud siren. At the time of the siren everyone needs to exit the park with all their belongings. Once the all clear is sounded games will resume. No one will be allowed to re-enter the park until the all clear is given.

**HOME TEAM.** The Home Team will be determined by a coin toss prior to the start of each game.

**DUGOUT ASSIGNMENT.**

The team at the top/left of the bracket will use the first base dugout.

The team at the bottom/right of the bracket will use the third base dugout.

If dugout is occupied from the previous game then that team will stay in that dugout.

**OFFICIAL GAME BALL.**

The official softball for the tournament has been provided by Worth Sports Company. All softballs must be approved by the ASA Executive Director in accordance with **Rule 3, Section 3, THE OFFICIAL BALL**, of the **ASA Official Rules of Softball.**

**GAME RULES.**

All playing rules and regulations for the tournament will be in accordance with the **ASA Official Rules of Softball.**

**CONDUCT.**

Managers and coaches are asked to have complete control of their players both on and off the field. Any report of damage by hotel management will be dealt with by the tournament committee in accordance with **Article 510, GENERAL REGULATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY, SECTION M, Team Conduct.**

**ELIGIBILITY.**

Please see the **ASA Official Rules of Softball** for clarifications and interpretations.

**PLAYER PASSES.**

Player passes will be distributed to rostered players and coaches/managers.

All participants must have a pass to gain entrance to the softball complexes.

Participants without player passes will be required to pay the daily admission price.

Passes will be distributed at the team check-in.

**SOUVENIRS.**

Souvenirs will be available at opening ceremonies and both days of play.
